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JA Central Ontario Company Program Fixed Costs & Profits Tax 2024-2025

Fixed Costs

Each Company Program team will be required to pay the fixed costs associated with running a business.

Through the implementation of fixed costs students are given a real-world perspective on the expenses associated with running and operating a small business. Companies should incorporate this cost when they plan their initial budget.

The total amount of the fixed costs per company is **\$200.00** – which will be invoiced in 2 installments.

The **first installment** for **\$100.00** is due on **Sunday, February 9th, 2025**

The **second installment** for **\$100.00** is due on **Sunday, April 6th, 2025**

For the second instalment, if your team did not make \$200 in profit, you are not required to pay the second amount of \$100. You must submit your income statement indicating that your profit is below \$200 to have your fixed costs waived.



Sales Profits Tax

All sales profits tax payments must be submitted no later than
Sunday, April 6th, 2025

Calculation of Sales Profits Tax:

$(\text{Total Sales/Revenue}) - (\text{Total Expenses}) = \text{Income before Profits Tax}$

$(\text{Income before Profits Tax}) \times (10\%) = \text{Profits Tax}$

$(\text{Income before Profits Tax}) - (\text{Profits Tax}) = \text{Net Income}$

*Net Income is what is used to calculate final ROI figures.

Example:

$\$5400 (\text{Sales/Revenue}) - \$4100 (\text{Expenses}) = \$1300 (\text{Profit})$

$\$1300 (\text{Profit}) \times 10\% (\text{Profits Tax Percentage Payable}) = \$130 (\text{profits tax due})$

$\$1300 - \$130 = \$1170 (\text{net income})$

Total Expenses may include:

Salaries, Commissions, Marketing and Incentives, Office Supplies, Bank Charges, Shareholders Report, Charitable Donations, Other Expenses.

If a company has made less than \$500 profit overall, they will not be required to submit profits tax to JA Central Ontario.



How to submit your payment

Both fixed costs as well as sales profits tax payments MUST be submitted by the appropriate due dates for companies to be eligible for any of the Company Program awards.

Fixed costs and sales profits tax payments can be submitted via **Interac Email Money Transfer:**
