JA Company Program empowers young people in grades 9-12 with the skills, connections and confidence to start their own business. Over 18 weeks, you'll meet like-minded students, connect with dedicated mentors and create, run and liquidate a business over 18 weeks.

Summary

- Each team will consist of 3 to 8 advisors and 10 to 25 high school students
- Program runs weekly from November – April (with breaks for holidays and March Break)
- Students and advisors will meet once a week for 3 hours
- There is no experience necessary to join the program, just your commitment to your team – just like any other extra curricular (like being part of a soccer team).
